Step 1. General Information

Step 2. Exterior doors

Choose your exterior doors: front, rear, service door (outside garage door), and garage to the house. When you select your front entrance doors you should consider side panels and decorative door lights. In most areas the door from the garage to the house must be a fire rated door of 90 minutes, which means that it would be a steel door with no wood edge styles.

You can select many styles of doors for your house: flush (no panels), 6-panel, 4-panel and decorative glass.

Step 6. Trim / Mouldings

There are many types and styles of mouldings available for you to select from. You also need to consider the material for your mouldings. You may choose from clear pine or oak, for stain and finish. Also available is finger-jointed primed pine, bare finger-jointed pine or poplar for painting. You can choose ornamental mouldings such as crown for your formal dining room, foyer or custom-designed mantel. You can select different profiles and materials for handrails for the steps. Pre-Fit Door can provide closet shelving in particleboard, poplar or pine to design your walk in closet.

Step 7. Stair Systems

To choose the parts for the stairs you would like to have in your new house you must decide the style of stair system. There are two main types to review, the first is Post –to Post design and the second is Over the Post. You also check your local building codes for rail height for the balusters that will be used in your stairs. In some areas a second hand rail is required along the wall and a handrail going to the basement should be considered.
